- A rating of the bill depending on how it could affect associations.
- A link to the text of the bill. Click on the number of the bill in the detailed information section and it will link to the actual text of the bill.
- A link to the bill's sponsor. Click on the bill sponsor's name and it will link to the contact information for the sponsor.
- A link to the committee currently considering the bill. Click on the committee name and it will link to the list of the committee members with their contact information.
