

SRCA ARCHITECTURAL APPLICATION CHECKLIST

Gates

All gates that can be seen from neighboring properties, including, but not limited to side yard gates and decorative courtyard gates require review and approval prior to installation. The addition of a gate requires disclosure to neighboring properties and Architectural Committee review and approval prior to installation. Other applications for replacement may be allowed on a staff level.

This checklist is for guidance ONLY-please refer to the SRCA Architectural Guidelines for the specific requirements relating to your project. You may require additional checklists, dependent upon the type of project proposed. Please contact our Architectural Liaison for additional information.

Please submit the following, in addition to your SRCA Architectural Application for SRCA review:

- Full color house photo (as seen from across the street)
- Photo of existing gate to be replaced.
- Photo of other existing gates that will remain.
- Measurements of gate if it will increase in size.
- Material and color sample.
- If gate is wood, additional photos of existing wood accents or dark trim colors will be required to help determine color and style consistency.
- Gates that change location or will substantially increase in size/style or color will require Architectural Committee review and approval. Please allow sufficient time for review.
