2021 SRCA Fall Events

All SRCA events are still to be determined. The board reviews the reopening plan each month which will determine types and sizes of events that can be held.

- **Movie In the Park**

- Friday, September 24th and Friday, October 1st have been reserved with the park. If we hold this event, SRCA would pass out sealed treats.

- **Boo Bash/Concert in the Park**

- Saturday, October 23rd
 - Genevieve to reach out to Storybook Entertainment to see if they hold socially distanced Halloween themed events, arts and crafts, etc.
 - Genevieve to look for other dates to hold Concert in the Park as an individual event. Genevieve to find a band for the event.

- **Community Wide Sale**

- Saturday, November 6th
 - The committee agreed to donate to Hospice of the Valley again.

- **Veterans Day Event**
 - Thursday, November 11th
 - Genevieve to contact the Veterans sub-committee regarding the event. Would the committee still participate in the planning and what are their thoughts on holding a scaled back event.
 - Recognize SR vets via SRCA communications. Give the vets an item from SRCA to show appreciation.
 - Place out American flags around the Ranch like last year.

- **Holiday Party and Boat Parade**
 - The committee agreed that we should definitely have some sort of holiday event even if it has to be scaled back.
 - The SR Park location by the lake where the boats ride by could be a second location to reduce the size at the community center.
 - It will be decided if we use a light/decorating company for the exterior of the community center and office on whether or not we hold the event. This cost comes from the event budget.

- **Events focused towards teens**
 - Look into partnering with the Boys & Girls Club.

- **Welcoming New Homeowners**
 - Hold quarterly meet and greet events. Residents meet with the board and executive director for Q&As in a casual setting. Offer coffee and donuts. Add an additional incentive for residents to participate.
 - Still hold the annual New Resident Cocktail Party once a year.
 - Genevieve will send committee members the SRCA New Resident Welcome packet to review once it has been updated.

- **Storybook Entertainment**
 - Genevieve will reach out for socially distanced options they may have for any Fall events.

- **Ideas for virtual / social distancing events**
 - Food trucks
 - Genevieve will contact the City of Scottsdale regarding what we may need to hold a food truck event at the SR Park; permits etc.
 - Hold virtual educational seminars versus games.
 - DIY, Aging in Place, Realtors, etc. – start with once a month
