**CALL TO ORDER:**

Greg Mona called the meeting to order at 4:31 p.m.

**APPROVAL OF**

**PREVIOUS MINUTES:**

**MOTION:** It was moved and seconded to approve the minutes from the December 8, 2020 meeting. Motion passed.

**AGENDA ITEMS:**

**Lake Sedimentation**

**Lake Dredging**

Tony Baccellia gave an overview of the dredging project in the two areas where excessive runoff comes from the drainage. The following is a summation of what the project entailed:

**Clubhouse Cove:**

- ❖ Dredged Clubhouse Cove for 9 days.
- ❖ Water depth 7' with 5' of solids.
- ❖ We removed 3' of solids in middle of cove leaving 2' of solids.
- ❖ On sides of cove, we removed 3' of solids leaving 6" to 1'.
- ❖ We took 8 truckloads of Solids and 2 truckloads of trash to landfill.
- ❖ We estimated we removed 240 yards of solids.

**EAST COVE:**

- ❖ 10 Days of Dredging.
- ❖ Water depth 8' with 6' of solids.
- ❖ We removed 4' of solids in cove leaving 2' of solids.
- ❖ On sides of cove, solids left range from 4" to 1'.
- ❖ We took 16 truckloads of solids and two loads of trash to landfill.
- ❖ We estimated we removed 400 yards of solids.

Kathe Barnes reported that the project came in within the budget approved by the board.

(Tony Baccellia left the meeting.)

SDS –NT Max Pond Treatment

Kathe Barnes reported the initial heavy treatment of this product was done over a course of a month by the lake maintenance crew. The next treatment will be done in July/August and then the final will be done in September/October. Initial thoughts were that the water quality has already shown some improvement from an aesthetic standpoint.

Greg Mona gave a report of his recent trips on the lake. He performed some initial depth shots and will repeat these every 3 months to help determine whether the microbes are working. The fishing has been encouraging with the fish being healthy and their color good.
