Lake Serena Update

Rick Amalfi stated that the lake had experienced more algae bloom in 2021 than had seen in the past. He is concerned about the high phosphate and chlorophyll levels at present and is recommending putting in more dye. It was discussed that it would be a good idea to put in some copper prior to that. This is in hopes to get ahead of a big spring bloom. Jason stated that he has not seen any other issues on the lake during his weekly visits.

SDS –NT Max Pond Treatment

Kathe Barnes questioned whether to continue with the microbes in the lake. Corey from NEWTECHBIO recommends doing the same amount this year as was done in 2021. The committee concurred.

Greg Mona stated he would go out on the lake to take new measurements of initial depth shots to see if there is any change.

Fishing Derby/Lake Fest

Genevieve Long stated that this event has been scheduled for Saturday, February 26th. The derby is 8:30 – 10:30 am and the fest is 11:00 am – 1:00 pm. SDL will be there to cook hamburgers and hot dogs. There will be boat rides, kayaks and bounce houses. The committee agreed to follow the past formats for the derby. Changes to the age groups may have to be made dependent upon who signs up.

The committee will let Kathe know if they are available to help at the derby. Marilyn Wolfe told Kathe she is available.
