Currently, there is a slight trace of Microcystis in the lake but not enough to warrant treating it. The weather is too cold for the algaecide to be effective. Rick has agreed to put a plan together in case the phosphorus levels worsen. He will also put together a recommended plan for algaecide and dye for 2024.

Dave Specht agreed to assist with researching various electric boat sizes to determine what the maximum length and width should be for Lake Serena.

Fish condos
