Laguna

Closing: The committee reviewed the information from the Scottsdale Unified School District about Phase II of their plan to close schools. Laguna Elementary is slated as one of the schools that will be closed due to declining enrollment. Enrollment is currently under 50% of capacity. Laguna and Redfield Schools would be moved to the current Cheyene Elementary campus at 100th St. and Frank Lloyd Wright. Currently, there are no plans to sell the property. The initial intent would be to repurpose the facility.

Peter Klausner put together a draft letter which was approved by the committee. The letter will be sent to the board for final approval.
